REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS – REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF LIGHT SYSTEM FROM QUARRY TOWER

The Cass County Emergency Services Board (ESB) is seeking proposals for Removal and Replacement of the Flash Technology FTB 324-2 Medium Intensity Obstruction Lighting System from the Quarry Tower, as follows:

The Quarry Tower is located at 18604 East 231st Street, Harrisonville, Missouri 64701. The scope of work involves removal and disposal of the obsolete lighting hardware, wiring, and hangers. Installing new LED 2 light system (top and middle beacons). The requirement for side-marker obstruction lights can be eliminated if the tower is registered as bird friendly.

General Conditions

--Pursuant to RSMo 285.530(1), by its sworn affidavit, the successful bidder will be required to affirm its enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees working in connection with the contracted services and that it does not knowingly employ any person who is an unauthorized alien in connection with the contracted services.

-- The successful Contractor, at its own expense, will be required to provide certificates for Comprehensive General Liability, Worker's Compensation and Automobile Liability **naming Cass County Emergency Services Board as an additional insured**, in the following amounts: Commercial General Liability Coverage and Automobile Liability Coverage shall be provided in the aggregate amount of not less than \$2,000,000 for all claims arising out of a single accident or occurrence and \$1,000,000 for any one person in a single accident of occurrence; Worker's Compensation coverage shall be no less than the statutory minimum.

-- Safety Training: Bidders are informed that the Project is subject to the requirements of Section 292.675, RSMo, which requires all contractors or subcontractors doing work on the Project to provide, and require its on-site employees to complete, a ten (10) hour course in construction safety and health approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration ("OSHA") or a similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations which is at least as stringent as an approved OSHA program. The training must be completed within sixty (60) days of the date work on the Project commences. On-site employees found on the worksite without documentation of the required training shall have twenty (20) days to produce such documentation.

-- The bidder shall submit with the Bid a list of all proposed subcontractors to be used on the project. The list shall indicate those portions of the work each subcontractor will be performing.

-- The CCESB reserves the right to reject any or all proposals. The CCESB shall award the proposal based upon its determination of the lowest and best proposal.

An optional pre-bid meeting will be held at the Quarry Tower on August 5, 2020 at 1 p.m. This meeting will provide an opportunity for bidders to view the Tower and ask any clarifying questions.
